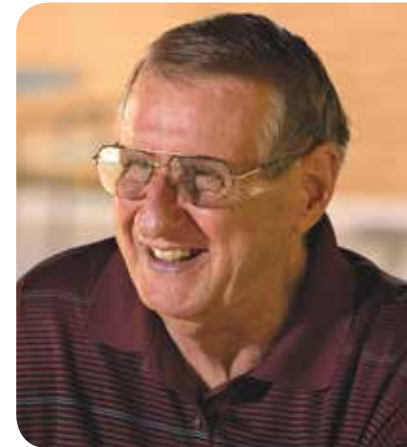

That's what our **Care by Day** program is all about.

Flexible Schedule

Because every family has different and unique needs, we offer flexible times within a 24-hour range.

Included Services

- Delicious meal(s) and healthy snacks while in attendance during meal times
- Dynamic calendar of events designed for mind and body fitness
- Complimentary attendance to outings (as appropriate)
- Access to all of The Fountains at Boca Ciega Bay amenities (i.e., billiards, live entertainment, parties/socials, boat rides, movie theater, etc.)
- Alzheimer's and dementia trained staff on hand 24 hours per day
- Nurse on property 24 hours per day
- Accommodations for resting
- Monthly Alzheimer's Support Group meetings

Care by Day Service Fee* starts at \$45.

Individuals may sign up for up to four hours, eight, 12 or 24 or even for a whole month, based on availability.

**The service fee includes programming services and care of incontinence. We ask that families furnish their own incontinence supplies.
